Rica Erickson was born in Boulder in 1908. Author, schoolteacher, farmer's wife and mother of four, she was better known for her books on wildflowers before the publication, beginning in 1979, of the *Dictionary of Western Australians*. With the exception of volume II, *Bond 1850–1868*, this series was revised for Australia's Bicentennial year. Rica's other works include *The Brand on His Coat*, a biographical account of Western Australian convicts, published in 1983.

Born in New Zealand, Gillian O'Mara married a Western Australian while living in Canada, and moved to Perth in 1975. It was while tracing her husband's family tree that she became interested in convicts and the convict era of Western Australia. Her research led to the publication, in 1990, of a booklet on the subject, *Convict Records of Western Australia: A Research Guide*, which has greatly assisted others through the mire of records.
