Farmer at Beverley & pastoralist at Katanning, holding extensive pastoral leases by 1860s. In 1868 bt. 60 acres freehold. By 1870 was listed as a farmer & victualler at Williams district employing 2 T/L men. By 1873 was listed as victualler at Kojonup. C/E.

Beverley, sheepfarmer 1860s-1868. Avon Loc.349/40acres, land at Narrogin. Employed 3 T/L men 1864 & 1868. C/E.

QUARTERMAINE, Charles Edmund, bp. 7.6.1863, d. 1944, son of Charles & Ellen Jane (nee Wright), m. c.1888 Louisa Jane TONDUT b. 4.12.1859, dtr. of Charles Francis & Caroline (nee Jackson). Chd. Albert b. 1888, Ethel, Clarence, Horace, Lavinia, Eric. West Wagin.

QUARTERMAINE, Eli, b. 1852, son of Elijah & Eliza, m. 8.2.1877 (RC Albany) Ellen Barron SMITH b. 18.12.1853, dtr. of William & Maria (nee Barron). Chd. Amy Louisa d. 1930, Agnes Matilda b. 1887. Katanning pioneer, Norri Lake 1879. Sheepfarmer & owner (Alm). Bought his brother's portion of "Yowangup" in 1909. Prot. Wife RC.

QUARTERMAINE, Elijah, b. 1809, d. 12.1888, arr. 12.1838 per Britomart at Frem, m. 30.12.1837 (Eng) Eliza DICKENSON b. 1818 d. 23.11.1873. Chd. Charles b. 1838 (at sea), Alfred b. 1841, Elijah b. 1842 d. 1916, Henry b. 1844 d. 1846, Emily b. 1847, Henry b. 1849, Elizabeth b. 1850, Eli b. 1852, John b. 1854, Frederick b. 1857 d. 1930, William Charles Alfred bp. 1860, E.C. b. & d. 1861, Richard b. & d. 1864. During 1840s worked for Dr Viveash at "Yangedine". In 1851 was grazing sheep at "Yowangup", Katanning, where he built a house in 1862.
